AUSTRALIAN DISABILITY PARKING PERMITS

On-Street Parking

On-street pay and display parking includes any parking bay installed on a road or street where meters are installed.

Vehicles displaying an Australian Disability Parking Permit may park without penalty in a parking bay marked with the International Symbol of Access.

Vehicles displaying an Australian Disability Parking Permit may also park for free in any time restricted parking bay within the Darwin Municipality for twice the period indicated on the sign. For example;

- 15 minutes extended to 30 minutes
- 1 hour extended to 2 hours
- 2 hours extended to 4 hours
- 3 hours extended to 6 hours

PLEASE NOTE: The driver of the vehicle must comply with normal parking restrictions, including paying for parking, once the free parking time has expired.

Off-Street Carparks - Pay and Display

An off-street carpark is an area that is made available for parking but is not located on a street or road. The following are Council's off-street carparks:

- Corner Mitchell and Daly Streets
- McLachlan Street opposite St Mary's Cathedral
- West Lane off Bennett Street
- Darwin Oval Carpark The Esplanade
- McMinn Street at the lower end of Bennett 96 Mitchell Street Street
- Corner Daly and Woods Streets
- Cavenagh Street next to the Post Office
- Chinatown off Smith Street
- Nichols Place off Harry Chan Avenue

Vehicles displaying disability parking permits may park in a designated disabled bay in all off-street carparks all day free of charge except for West Lane Car Park and Chinatown Car Park. Payment is not required for parking in a non designated disability bay in any off street car park (except for West Lane Car Park and Chinatown Car Park). Persons displaying a valid permit who park in a designated disabled bay in either West Lane Car Park or Chinatown Car Park may park for twice the time paid

CONDITIONS OF USE

The Australian Disability Parking Permit is for your use only and must not be loaned or given to any other person.

The permit must be clearly displayed so the expiry date and permit number are visible from the exterior of the vehicle (on the left hand side of your dash).

Permit is not to be displayed when the permit holder is not using the vehicle.

You must comply with concession entitlements in the location where your vehicle is parked.

The permit is transferable from vehicle to vehicle provided the vehicle is being used by the permit holder. Permit may be revoked for any breach of any of the conditions of use.
