## **DARWIN CITY COUNCIL REQUIREMENTS Work Zone Traffic Management**

The following sets out Darwin City Council's Traffic Management requirements for works conducted within or impacting on the general usage of Council's road reserves and or land vested in Council.

Works having impact or effect on traffic and or pedestrian movements within the Darwin Municipality may require a permit under Councils By Laws. A condition of the permit is the requirement to submit a traffic management plan/diagram prepared by an appropriately qualified person for acceptance by Council prior to works.

Depending on complexity and duration of works, an authorised traffic management plan and or a diagram shall be developed in accordance with Australian Standard 1742.3 Traffic Control Devices for works on roads and Australian Standard 4360 Risk Management and should include but not limited to details on temporary connections, access to adjacent properties, traffic guidance, traffic control devices, maintenance and restoration. Once submitted and suitability determined, permits are then issued.

The plan/diagram needs to be designed by an accredited Work Zone Traffic Management level 1 and implemented by no less than an Zone Traffic Management level 2 & 3 accredited person.

Application and submissions must be made at least 7 days prior to proposed commencement of work.
