PRE-CYCLONE CLEANUP Saturday 12 September 2009 “Darwin – Let’s Move It”

The first stage of the annual Darwin pre-cyclone cleanup is underway this weekend. The Northern Suburbs will be tackled first (Alawa, Anula, Brinkin, Jingili, Karama, Leanyer, Lyons, Malak, Marrara, Moil, Nakara, Tiwi, Wagaman, Wanguri & Wulagi).

Residents are asked to put out items on Saturday for collection by Council staff on Sunday.

Darwin City Council CEO Brendan Dowd stressed the importance of preparing for the cyclone season “it has been our experience that if we can clean up now, the risk of flying debris is reduced in case of cyclonic weather” he said.

What to put out.

Bits of old roofing, timber, iron, white goods, waste building products, broken furniture. These items should be placed safely on the nature strip (keeping the footpaths clear for pedestrians) on Saturday 12 September and which will be collected on Sunday 13 September 2009.

What NOT to put out.

Garden refuse, car bodies, chemicals, or commercial waste **will not be collected.**
