Pre-Cyclone Clean up Success

The second stage of the annual pre-cyclone clean up held last weekend was a huge success with 140 tonnes of potential cyclone debris removed on Sunday.

Nightcliff	22 tonnes
Millner	19 tonnes
Stuart Park	14 tonnes and a 1/3 of the suburb to go
Ludmilla	14 tonnes and a bit still to do.

It is important to remember that over the next few days additional waste will be collected from locations that have either been missed in the collection.

Acting Lord Mayor Helen Galton thanks all those involved "It is significant that this tonnage of material will not be around just in case we experience cyclonic weather" She said "Many thanks go to all the staff that participated and also the volunteers from Emergency Services, Correctional Services and Neighbourhood Watch".
