Kormilda College Helps Ambon Sister City

Darwin City Council and Kormilda College donated equipment and funds totalling \$3000 through the Ambon Sister City Community Committee to a State Senior High School in Ambon (SMU5), Indonesia.

Kormilda College raised \$1000 towards the purchase of language and/or music equipment and Darwin City Council donated \$2000 towards the purchase of sporting and other equipment.

The Chairman of the Ambon Committee, Mr Rick Setter visited Ambon in August 2008 and presented the donated equipment and funds to the school at a special assembly attended by the Mayor of Ambon, local dignitaries and hundreds of students and their families.

Mr Setter, as Council's representative, was presented with a framed 3D picture handmade from mother of pearl. Council wishes to pass on this gift to Kormilda College in recognition of their continued fundraising efforts for SMU5 Ambon.

The gift will be presented by The Lord Mayor to Kormilda College Middle School at their assembly on Thursday 27 November 2008 at 1pm.

Mrs Johana Hursepuny, an exchange teacher from Ambon will be present at the assembly and available for interview. Johana is a teacher from State Senior High School Number 5 and was present at the event held in Ambon in August.
