Bombing Commemoration WWW Coverage

Lord Mayor Graeme Sawyer commended the strong interest by local media organisations including Larrakia Radio on covering the February 19 Bombing of Darwin Commemoration. Mr Sawyer said "Coverage of this event via the internet will allow veterans and families all over the world access to the Commemoration".

Larrakia Radio 94.5FM, Darwin's only Indigenous Radio Station, will broadcast the entire Bombing of Darwin 67th Commemoration Ceremony live on Thursday 19 February from 9.00am Darwin time.

Chief Executive Officer of Radio Larrakia, Donna Odegaard's father, Leo Odegaard, recorded a personal first hand account of the bombing as he was there during the Darwin historic event.

"This significant broadcasting event will allow the many who are unable to attend the historic ceremony hear the entire event live uninterrupted from their home, communities, Aged Care Centres, hospitals and nursing homes here in Darwin, across the Northern Territory, in other capital cities and now around the world" Ms Odegaard said.

Radio Larrakia will commence the live broadcast from 9.00am with Larrakia Radio personality Willie G hosting the broadcast through to the completion of the entire ceremony.
