Her books will be available for purchase at the event. Rowe is the ABC's best-selling Australian pre-school author and illustrator. Her books have sold more than one million copies, published in more than 14 countries and in nine languages.

This month will see the release of her latest four books, Hug Me, Bug Me, Feed Me, Dress Me, from her new Baby Boo Buggy Books series, especially designed for babies on the move.

Jeannette's work as a writer has grown from a strong educational base. Originally she worked as an art teacher and curriculum writer encompassing all levels of primary education. She began her highly successful career with her award-winning book 'Sallywag' more than 15 years ago. With the birth of her daughter in 1995, her work changed from more complicated watercolour and pencil drawings, to her new bright and bold style to accommodate her daughter's love of bright colours, animals and surprises. This new formula resulted in more than 50 highly successful books for babies through to pre-schoolers.
