Hall is a third-generation pilot. He flew solo in a glider at age 15, got his pilot's license at 18, and has flown more than 6000 hours in various aircraft. A decorated former Wing Commander in the Royal Australian Air Force, he was named Fighter Pilot of the Year in 1997 and became a Fighter Combat (Top Gun) Instructor.
