Group similar items together



Leave a defined space between groups of items

Separate teams will collect specific materials throughout the clean up. (e.g. whitegoods, scrap metal, e-waste etc.)

- By correctly separating your items, you will ensure that as many items as possible are collected for recycling
- Items up to 1.5 metres long will be collected
- Up to two cubic metres will be collected
- For safety reasons please remove doors from fridges

Keep footpaths clear and be mindful of the safety of Council workers on the road.
