Categories

The Champion Award

A person who has made an outstanding contribution to the community by advocating for the rights and well-being of people with disabilities.

Criteria:

1. The person must have a disability.
2. They have made a big difference in the Darwin community by improving conditions, services, well-being, or understanding for people with disabilities.
3. The person has a record of being a champion for the rights of people with disabilities.

The Rising Star Award

This award is for a person under 25 years old who is actively helping their school, workplace, or community by advocating for the rights and well-being of people with disabilities.

Criteria:

1. The person must be under 25 years old and have a disability.
2. They are continuously making a positive difference in their school, workplace, or community.
3. The person advocates for the rights and well-being of people with disabilities.
