
# **FERALSCAN APP USER GUIDE**

### STEP 1

- Download the FeralScan app.
- Allow *FeralScan* to view your location while using the app when prompted.








## STEP 2

- From the home page choose FERAL CAT, then click Record Sighting.
- If this is your first time, click **Register** to create an account or record the sighting by entering your email address.










## STEP 3


## Complete the form within the app:


- # Enter the date observed.
- Location: (auto-detected or click the globe to place a marker on the map).
- Select the number of cats seen.
- Select the status: *Live* or *Dead*. If live, you will see questions 5-7.



### STEP 4

- Select the approximate age (Adult or Kitten).
- Select the coat colour of the cat.
- Check Add habitat information to display and then select one:
  - Roadside near road, under cars, or carpark
  - Native vegetation near protected areas.









### STEP 5

- In the *Notes* section, please include:
  - the suburb where you saw the cat.

If applicable, please describe the following:

- any signs of injury or poor health (such as wounds, limping, or hair loss)
- hunting activity (if the cat was chasing or hunting animals other than cats).





## STEP 6

- Upload a photograph (optional).
- Under privacy settings check Display this record to public users.
- Click the **Submit** button.
