Must Do 🗣

Sign in

On arrival please sign in. If someone at the session is diagnosed with an infectious disease, we can notify everyone.

Keep your hands clean

Wash or sanitise your hands when you arrive at Fun Bus, regularly throughout the session and also at the end of the session [sanitiser is at the sign in table and bathrooms may be used for handwashing].

Cover your cough and sneeze

When you sneeze or cough into your elbow rather than your hands or into a tissue and then throw away the tissue and sanitise hands.

Keep your distance

Parents/carers to maintain physical distancing of 1.5m from each other. Minimise contact with other family's children. Please follow the signs, e.g. only two adults per mat.

Maintain clean toys and equipment

We have set up a cleaning station, which have a supply of have cleaning materials. Help yourself with wipes to clean toys before and after use. Parents/carers need to ensure they clean any items that their child may cough or sneeze on or put in or near their face.
