All parks, ovals, reserves, gardens and beaches under Council's care and control, are declared dog exercise areas. There are also some areas within the Darwin municipality where owners cannot take their dogs


Dogs are not allowed in the following locations:*

- Plavarounds within 10 metres
- · Barbeque areas within 10 metres
- Fast Point Reserve
- * Guide Doas Permitted



- Markets
- · Gardens Oval One
- · Nightcliff Oval

Dogs are allowed in all parks, ovals, gardens and beaches under Council's care and control*



- · Accompanied by its owner under effective control
- Female dogs in heat are not permitted in exercise areas

In exercise areas, dogs are required to be restrained by a lead if:

- · Organised sporting activities are in progress
- The dog is being exercised on or within 10 metres of a shared path
- · In exercise areas, the owner/handler must ensure the dog follows the Animal Management By-Laws

What is effective control?

In an off-leash area, effective control means:

- · The dog is immediately responsive to a voice command of its owner
- · The dog is not a female dog in heat
- The owner is carrying a suitable leash

In an on-leash area, effective control means:

• The dog is restrained by a suitable leash and being held by a person who is competent to restrain the dog or prevent the dog from breaking free
