Casuarina Aquatic and Leisure Centre Community Room Hearing Assistance Devices Usage Guide

The neckloops provided connect the audio output from the IR Receiver unit into a hearing aid equipped with a T-coil. Headsets have also been provided for those without hearing aids.

TO USE WITH A T-COIL HEARING AID

 Place the IR Receiver unit's cloth lanyard and the neckloop around your neck and slide the neckloop's cord lock up to a comfortable position

(Manufacturer's note: cord lock adjustment will slightly affect the induction field strength)



- Plug the neckloop into the headphone jack on the IR Receiver unit
- Turn on the unit and set the volume to 3
- Turn the switch on your hearing aid to the T position and adjust the volume for comfortable listening
- If the sound is weak, increase the volume on the IR Receiver unit

TO USE WITHOUT A T-COIL HEARING AID

- Place the IR Receiver unit's cloth lanyard around your neck
- Plug the headset provided into the headphone jack on the IR Receiver unit
- Turn on the unit and set the volume to 2
- Place headset over your ears
- If the sound is weak, increase the volume on the IR Receiver unit

Turn OFF IR Receiver unit and return to its charger when finished using
