In a letter dated 2 March 2017, Council again advised Ms Gill that Council will not respond to Public Questions regarding Lakeside Drive, excepting those that are administratively based.

That said, to date, a total of 140 questions have been posed by Ms Gill and responded to by Council.

In the most recent correspondence to Council, dated Monday 24 July, 2017 Ms Gill accuses Council of not complying with the NT *Information Act* by not providing reasons for decisions in regard to her request for information under that Act.

On each occasion that Council has corresponded with Ms Gill in response to her request and in accordance with the NT *Information Act*, reasons for the non-supply of documents have been provided.

On Monday 24 July, in an email from Ms Gill, she states: "...there is very reasonable cause to suspect that the City of Darwin Council Environment and Infrastructure Department harbours corruption." Council categorically refutes that allegation.
