 - First Nations Ambassador has been appointed to represent the First Nations based in Australia to connect with the rest of the world. The Ambassador will lead the process of embedding Indigenous perspectives, experiences, and interests across the work of the Department of Foreign Affairs Trade, including the development of a First Nations Foreign Policy.

 Sam Bennett who has extensive tourism experience and skills, and
 - a further update will be provided on the Board representative from Tourism Top End in the International Relations Advisory Committee

 - International Delegations scheduled to happen:
 - Delegation to Timor Leste to reinforce and finalise the agreement in September
 - Delegation to India in October
 - Delegation to Indonesia in November
