'City of Darwin received a request from the Consulate General of India to join in celebrating India's 75 years of Independence by participating in Diwali and lighting up the Civic Center.

Diwali is a major celebration in India along with much of South East Asia, and is celebrated by people of Hindu, Janis, Sikh and Buddhist cultures, giving it cultural significance to many people in Darwin.

Diwali symbolizes the spiritual victory of light over darkness, good over evil, love over hate, joy over sadness and knowledge over ignorance.

Diwali lasts for five days beginning on the 15th day of the Hindu month of Kartik, which in 2021 is November 4th. The importance of Diwali to the Hindu culture and calendar also makes it important to our friends in the Hindu city of Denpasar. The cost for Diwali lights will come from the International Relations Budget.'
