- b) <u>Make recommendations to Council Continue to identify Identify</u> actions that City of Darwin may take to improve its facilities, services and programs for greater arts and cultural outcomes.; whilst recognising and supporting Darwin's diverse social, cultural and creative resources for all in the Darwin community.
- c) Identify gaps, issues and challenges for arts and cultural development that City of Darwin can advocate for and/or partner with businesses, services and organisations to address.
- d) Advise Council on ways to amplify arts and cultural strengths through strategic support of community and cultural groups, organisations and activities.
- <u>ce</u>) <u>e) Advise Advocate to Council and , educate and inform Council them on</u> <u>relevant creative</u>, arts and cultural considerations and needs, industry <u>best practice</u> and <u>developments</u>, and rights. on ways to advocate for arts and culture through providing education and information on community and cultural needs and rights through positive and proactive media, social marketing, community events, festivals, forums and other initiatives in partnership with Council.~

- <u>eh</u>) Support the development and maintenance of a register of peers for the establishment of <u>relevant temporary</u>-sub-committees, working groups and/or panels as <u>required</u>. of appropriate members of the community
- fi) Act as a conduit for the sharing of ideas, resources, funding and employment opportunities between Council and <u>the_Darwin's creative</u>

community and provide mutual support and assistance in developing and implementing community and cultural activities in Darwi_n.
