- Community Member Richard Creswick:
  - Background information of Remembering Cyclone Tracy Inc was provided with the aim to represent the views of Cyclone Tracy survivors in any commemorative activities,
  - the first project initiated was the creation of a register of Cyclone Tracy survivors through an online survey tool as well as distribution of paper forms which has already garnered around 200 forms for registration. Posters have likewise been prepared that contains a QR code for ease of access in registration by the public,
  - Royal Mint has been approached with a request and petition to produce commemorative coins for the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Cyclone Tracy,
  - lastly, an agreement with the Northern Territory Government (NTG) is in place to issue special numbered plates to commemorate this event, and
  - the Lord Mayor reaffirmed that Remembering Cyclone Tracy Inc can still continue the outstanding initiatives it has started and collaboratively work with Council.
