### 17.2 Clean-up of Esplanade Clifftops

Member R M Knox noted her appreciation for the clean-up of the Esplanade clifftops but weeds will return immediately if the area is not urgently replanted with ground cover and covered with mulch. What plans are there for revegetating the area and when will it be done? (noting that coffee bush seeds last 40 years).

*The Chief Executive Officer responded and advised that Council are considering a Stage 2, noting that considerations have included once the invasive species were removed how the removal would change the cliff face. Planning is underway, with some of the work to be completed by the wet season.*

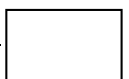
