- 1. Considering the huge amount of dumping that has occurred at 21 Lakeside drive and the cost this has incurred on ratepayers are there plans to erect signs to discourage dumping in this area? If not why not?
- 2.During the last year and 4 months that I have been engaging with Council regarding the area of 21 Lakeside Drive I have found that there is a very disturbing lack of documentation such as work plans , work maps or records of any kind for some work carried out in this area. It seems from information I have received from Council that for the most part the C of D Council Environment and Infrastructure Department more or less just please themselves as to what work they properly document.

Will there be proper documentation of operations including work orders and work maps to indicate where topsoil is to be used in this area or will Council just continue do as they see fit without bothering to lodge adequate records as is expected of any professional organization?

- 3. Considering the sensitive nature of this area and the impact on nearby properties the health of this area would have in the event of a surge will these work maps showing where topsoil is to be deposited be available for interested parties to view prior to this work being carried out?
- 4. What documentation is usually required to be in place prior to work being carried out for C of D Council by contractors? And what records are usually kept regarding work carried out by C of D Council contractors?
- 5. Is an itemised estimated budget required to be in place before any operation is begun?
- 6. Why has Council evaded admission that Council directed and organised the fill used in drain number 12 at Lakeside drive which has been lined with tyres and tons of broken concrete and pieces of bitumen?
