PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide an update on the Sister Cities Soiree Event

BACKGROUND

Darwin Sister Cities Soiree was held on Saturday 16 August 2025 as part of the Darwin Festival 2025.

- The event included a Sister City themed trivia game, performances from local cultural groups representing Darwin's Sister Cities and the presentation of the Grand Final winners of the 'Darwin Sister City Award Storytelling Competition 2025.
- The Sister Cities Soiree was an action within the 2024-2026 Sister Cities Action Plan endorsed by Council for delivery.

DISCUSSION

Darwin Sister Cities Soiree was delivered as a priority under the City of Darwin's Sister Cities Action Plan 2024-2026. The event achieved the objective of promoting Darwin's international relations program and celebrating the Sister Cities culture with the Darwin community during the Darwin Festival through food, performances and live music.

The event was held on Saturday 16 August 2025 as part of the Darwin Festival. It was delivered through a partnership agreement between City of Darwin and the Darwin Festival.

The program included five cultural performances, trivia game (focused on education and promoting Darwin's Sister Cities), and the unveiling of the Grand Prize winners of the 'Darwin Sister City Awards – Storytelling Competition 2025'.

The event was attended widely by the public as part of the Darwin Festival Program at the Darwin Port Bandstand.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide an update on the recently concluded 2025 Sister City Awards - Storytelling Competition.

BACKGROUND

The Darwin Sister City Awards – Storytelling Competition is an annual activity run by the City of Darwin to promote cross cultural engagement, knowledge sharing and creativity between amateur and professional creatives across Darwin and our Sister/Friendship Cities. Historically the competition was focused on photography, however in 2025 the competition was expanded to include two new categories – Poetry and Film.

This year's Darwin Sister City Awards – Storytelling Competition achieved the following objectives:

- Featured creative talent from Darwin's Sister Cities that connect, inspire, inform, and create awe.
- Inspired creativity amongst Darwin's seven Sister Cities and promoted the unique bond share with Darwin.

COMPETITION OUTCOME BRIEFING

The competition was open to amateur and professional photographers, poets and film producers, running from December 2024 – March 2025. City of Darwin received 69 eligible submissions across the four categories. Entries were submitted across Darwin and our Sister Cities: Ambon, Denpasar, Dili, and Haikou. Grand prize winners were acknowledged via the Discover Darwin website and at a formal ceremony during the Darwin Festival – City of Darwin's Sister Cities Soiree event.

Submissions from each Sister City:

- Haikou 52%
- Denpasar 20%
- Darwin 15%
- Ambon 9%
- Dili 4%

The submissions per category were broken down into the following categories:

Photo – Landscape – 42%

- Photo People 28%
- Poetry 26%
- Short Film 4%

The Grand Prize Winners for each category included:

Photography - Landscape: Zhonghua Shi, Haikou

Description: Mr Shi describes his photo as capturing Haikou Bay's unique and adapted conditions and ecological features which have become a landmark for citizens and tourists to relax, play, dine, and shop.



Photography – People: Ni Putu Bunga Kaniska Sanubari, Denpasar

Description: This portrait depicts a couple dressed in traditional Balinese songket and endek weaving, with the artist explaining that it symbolises the King and Queen of Denpasar, united in love and tradition.



Grand Prize - Poetry: Chenghan Tang, Haikou

Description: This engaging poem stood out as having a unique theme and approach, juxtaposing Haiku and Darwin's natural ecology with that of technological development.

Sister Ports: Binary Code of Tides

At 20°N and 12°S,
two ports hum in mirrored syntax—
Haikou's docks parse monsoon data,
Darwin's terminals decrypt dry winds.

We splice our latitudes with fiber-optic kelp, submarine cables thrumming coral algorithms: your mangrove roots compile silt into firewalls, my volcanic bedrock hosts cloud archives.

Cranes stack containers like coral polyps,
steel reefs blooming in shared currents—
your saltwater crocodiles blink with satellite tags,
my coconut palms broadcast Wi-Fi pollen.

At dawn, your frigatebirds ping my skyscrapers,
encrypted nests in glass spires;
by dusk, my fishing fleets stream live coordinates,
pulsing through Darwin's arterial bays.

We speak in hybrid glyphs:

boiling tea steams with outback dust,
didgeridoo vibrations tessellate Qiong opera scales—
fireworks detonate twin auroras over the Arafura Sea.

Sister cities don't weep—we debug typhoons,
rebooting horizons when cyclones glitch the code.

Tides rise as executable waves,
compiling moonlit .exe into dawn's silent shore.

Grand Prize - Short Film: Putu Bagus Windhi Santika, Denpasar

Description: The talented film maker provides a beautiful depiction of Darwin and Denpasar's cultural and community connections through the story of a young Denpasar student who is grappling with the emotional turmoil of leaving her home and family in Denpasar to travel to Darwin to study.

BACKGROUND

City of Darwin's Sister City Program is an important component of Darwin's international relations. The purpose of this program is to foster and develop international relationships with Sister Cities and promote international understanding through education, cultural exchanges and economic development activities that benefit the community.

City of Darwin's international relations efforts contribute to:

- **Community and culture** people who visit and settle in Darwin support City of Darwin's vision for a creative, connected, and inclusive city.
- **Economy** access to markets, commercial opportunities, international students, and tourists all contribute to Darwin's economic prosperity.

The Sister Cities Action Plan 2024-2026 was endorsed by Council on 27 August 2024. It is an updated two-year implementation plan developed to ensure projects and initiatives align with economic development strategy and broader strategic priorities. The current Action Plan follows on from the previous Sister Cities Action Plan 2023-2024.

The purpose of the Action Plan is to:

- · identify initiatives collectively
- gain formal budgetary approvals to facilitate the implementation of initiatives or projects
- establish and coordinate key success indicators in place
- measure progress and delivery.
