PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to update the Tree Advisory Committee (committee) on Council's resolutions regarding Tree Advisory Committee Recommendations.

KEY ISSUES

- At the meeting held on 24 August 2023, the committee provided recommendations to Council on the City of Darwin Greening Strategy, Report Establishing a Resilient Urban Forest and Preferred and Not Recommended to be Planted Tree Lists and Trial Species List.
- Council at its meeting held on 26 September 2023, adopted all recommendations excluding recommendation two, page 25 of the Greening Strategy, *that Council endorses a 1% change to canopy coverage as the target over the 10 years of the strategy.*
- Council has requested that the committee provides further clarification on canopy coverage in the Darwin Greening Strategy.

DISCUSSION

The committee provided a number of recommendations to Council on the City of Darwin Greening Strategy, Report Establishing a Resilient Urban Forest and Preferred and Not Recommended to be Planted Tree Lists and Trial Species List. Council considered these at its meeting on 26 September 2023.

One recommendation was excluded - recommendation two, page 25 of the Greening Strategy, *that Council endorse a 1% change to canopy coverage as the target over the 10 years of the strategy*. Council has requested that the committee provide further clarification on canopy coverage in the Darwin Greening Strategy.
