#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to seek endorsement of the proposed changes to the Tree Advisory Committee's Functions and Membership sections of the Terms of Reference.

- 1. In accordance with Clause 9.1 of the Tree Advisory Committee's Terms of Reference it is a requirement for the Terms of Reference to be reviewed annually by the Committee and any changes to be presented to Council for endorsement.
- 2. At the Tree Advisory Committee meeting of 23 November 2023, the committee were informed that a review would be undertaken at the first scheduled meeting in 2024.
- 3. City of Darwin officers have conducted a review of the Functions and Membership sections of the Terms of Reference and the suggested changes are presented for endorsement.

## **Terms of Reference Review**

#### **4 FUNCTIONS**

The functions of the Tree Advisory Committee as required, are to:

- a) Review and monitor the implementation of the City of Darwin Greening Strategy actions on an annual basis
- b) Review and monitor the implementation of the actions in the report Establishing a Resilient Urban Forest for Darwin on an annual basis
- c) Review and update the document Preferred Trees for Darwin on a five yearly basis or as external circumstances require
- d) Review and update the document Trees Not Recommended to be Planted on a five yearly basis or as external circumstances require
- e) Investigate and make recommendations on Species that are Colourful, Tropical and/or Flowering.

#### **5 MEMBERSHIP**

In accordance with the *Local Government Act 2019* (NT), City of Darwin shall appoint suitably qualified individuals to be members of the Committee based on selection criteria related to their expertise, experience, dedication, and commitment to the purpose of the group.

#### Membership Provisions

- a) Up to two (2) community members, and
- b) Up to six (6) four (4) organisational memberships consisting of representation from:
  - i. Australian Institute of Landscape Architects
  - ii. Northern Territory Arboriculture Association
  - iii. Larrakia Nation
  - Parks and Wildlife (George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens)
  - v. Territory Natural Resource Management
  - vi. Urban Development Institute of Australia (NT)
- c) Two (2) Council Members on the Committee, the Lord Mayor, and one Council Member. There may also be an alternate Council Member.

Observers with specialist skills and experience may also attend by invitation of the Committee and/or Council.

The term of membership for community members is two (2) years.
