TOTAL LOANS


The loans statistics are for total borrowing from all 4 libraries, comparisons are from the same period for the previous 3 years.


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



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SELF CHECKOUT USAGE


Library customers have steadily increased the usage of the self checkout machines which were installed at Casuarina Library during the refurbishment. 10.5% of Casuarina Library members used the self checkout and 33% of Casuarina loans were done on the self checkout machines in March.

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

These statistics show total library members for each library over the past 3 months.




STORY TIME ATTENDANCE

These statistics are for attendance at our regular programs. Storytime is held each day throughout the week at all four libraries with a total of 11 sessions held weekly. The average attendance at each session is 32. Attendance decreases during the school holiday period and once school has gone back the parents and caregivers return to the sessions.

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
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COMPUTER USE - MEMBERS

COMPUTER USE - NON MEMBERS


Non-members who use the libraries Internet access pay \$3 per 30 minutes.

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

Reference statistics are collected from the customers who come into the library and seek assistance from the library staff, and include items requested by customers.




INTER LIBRARY LOANS - REQUEST TO OTHER LIBRARIES

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

These are requests by other libraries to DCC, requests come from other libraries in the NT and from Interstate.




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STOCK COUNT

These statistics show the total stock count at each library and the comparison of the size of the collection over the past three years. Collections at Casuarina, City and Karama have all decreased whilst the Nightcliff collection has grown. Overall the total libraries collections have decreased by 7% in the past 3 years.
