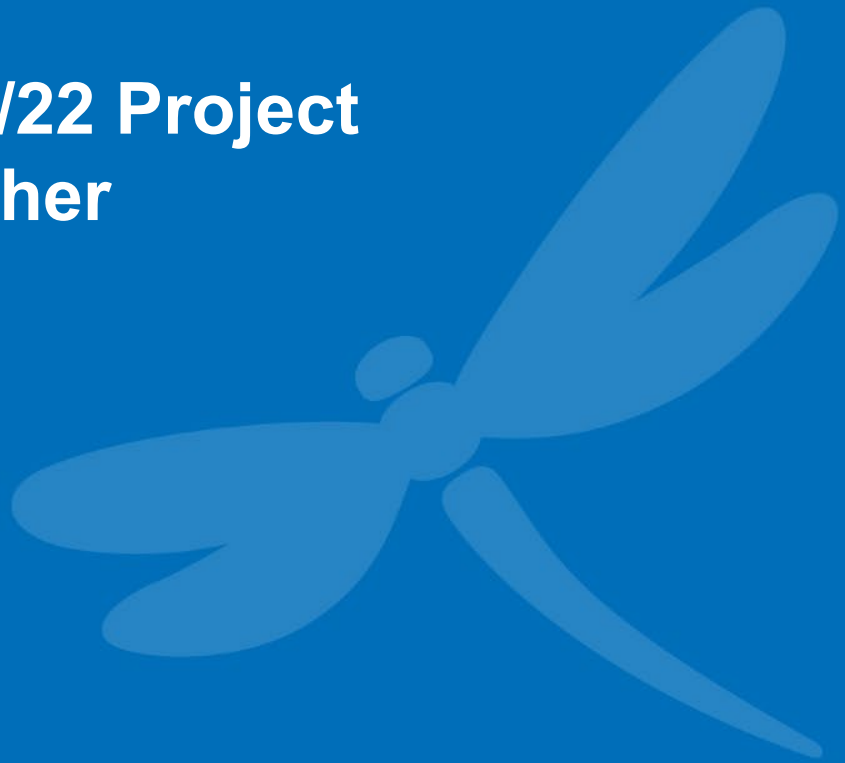


Black Spot Program 2021/22 Project Nomination Report - Further Information

2nd Ordinary Meeting –
30 March 2021



Background

- The NTG-funded Electronic Speed and Traffic Calming Project, was undertaken in collaboration with City of Darwin.
- As part of the project, a desktop road safety assessment was undertaken, considering 85th percentile speeds, accident data and community interest to arrive at ranking for the 36 Schools candidate Schools in Darwin.
- The 11 highest ranked Schools (Tranche 1) were addressed with the installation of 20 permanent speed check signs.
- Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics has encouraged City of Darwin to nominate an additional Black Spot project to the 2021/22 programme for the installation of a further \$500,000 worth of permanent speed check signs around additional Schools in Darwin.



Schools Addressed in NTG-Funded Project

The 11 Darwin Schools addressed in this project (Tranche 1) were:

- Alawa Primary School;
- Anula Primary School;
- Dripstone Middle School;
- Henbury School;
- Jingili Primary School;
- Leanyer Primary School / Good Shepard Lutheran College;
- Millner Primary School;
- Moil Primary School;
- Parap Primary School; and
- Sanderson Middle School.

COD's Nominated Schools

- Based on the above ranking, COD staff have put forward 14 Schools for treatment with permanent speed check signs as its additional 2021/22 Black Spot programme nomination (being the first 14 Schools listed) in the Briefing Paper.
- This would be Tranche 2 and some of Tranche 3 as identified in the NTG-funded project.



New Information from the NTG

- Subsequent to submission of the Briefing Paper on this matter, DIPL have advised that, pending discussions with the Nightcliff Primary School, it is likely that that School will also be treated with permanent speed check signs as part of the NTG-funded project.
- It is not intended at this stage to treat Nightcliff Middle School with permanent speed check signs as other works are intended as part of the project.
- It is therefore considered that Nightcliff Primary School should be replaced with The Essington School, being the next highest ranked School in the list of 14 Darwin Schools put forward.



Revised Recommendation to Council

- THAT Council endorse the additional project nomination for the installation of Speed Check signs for Darwin Schools as part of the 2021/2022 Black Spot Programme in accordance with the scope outlined in this report, with the replacement of Nightcliff Primary School with The Essington School.
