

Changes to Darwin Suburb Boundaries

In March 2007, the Minister for Planning and Lands approved changes to suburb boundaries and the creation of new suburbs in the greater Darwin area.

These changes were the result of extensive consultation over a two year period.

The Place Names Committee, in conjunction with the Department of Planning and Infrastructure, is now proposing to make some minor changes to the boundaries to align the boundaries with identifiable features (ie cadastral boundaries and road centrelines).

Boundary changes are proposed between the suburbs of:

- Larrakeyah and The Gardens (in vicinity of Burnett Place)
- Darwin City and Stuart Park (in vicinity of Dinah Beach Road)
- Parap and Stuart Park and Woolner (along Stuart Highway), and
- The Narrows and Woolner (along Stuart Highway).

A paper with diagrams showing the proposed suburb boundary changes is attached for your information.

The Committee seeks Council's support and/or comments on the proposed suburb boundary changes.

Proposed suburb boundary changes

Darwin Municipality

Background

To make the boundaries between Darwin suburbs align with the public's expectation of where the boundary is (ie centreline of roads or cadastral boundary), it is necessary to make minor amendments to some suburb boundaries, in particular along the Stuart Highway between Stuart Park and Winnellie and at the intersection of Dinah Beach Road and Tiger Brennan / Frances Bay Drives.
