5. GENERAL BUSINESS

5.1 Consultation – Rebecca Jennings

YAC provided feedback on the following questions - "Do you think young people understand why they vote in an election?", "Do young people know how to enrol to vote?", and provided questions and feedback to Rebecca regarding the political system, personal experiences as young people and voting for those whose first language is not English. Rebecca discussed the advantages of including the perspectives of young people in Council and political consultation for major plans and ideas. "What are key issues that Darwin is facing?" and "What are current issues affecting young people in Darwin?". YAC member had questions regarding the policies on the SMART Darwin cameras on the esplanade and their features such as infa-red, face recognition and wifi monitoring. There are privacy concerns in terms of where this information is being stored and who has access to it. YAC member has concerns about the Northern Territory potentially losing one of its lower house seats in Federal Parliament due to population decline. YAC believes only one person to represent the Northern Territory would be underrepresentative of all the various regions and cultures in the NT.

Whilst the MAYS survey is aimed at 15 – 19 year olds, YEO has duplicated a similar survey for 12-14 and 20-25 year olds to gather further a fuller data set for use in the re-

development of Council's next Youth Strategy. YAC members have been presented with an opportunity for paid work to assist in conducting the surveys around Darwin.
