

Disability Parking Permits

Terms and conditions

On-street parking in Darwin

To park in a marked disabled parking bay

- Display the disability parking permit at all times.
- Follow the time limit shown on the sign.
- If the sign says “PAID” or “PAY & DISPLAY”, permit holders need to pay for half of the allowed parking time.



To park in a regular timed bay

- Display the disability parking permit at all times.
- Under the Australian Road Rules, permit holders are entitled to double the amount of time stated on the sign.
- Permit holders must pay for the entire time the vehicle is parked.



Location	Time allowed	Payment required
15-minute zones	30 minutes	No charge
30-minute zones	2 Hours	No charge
2P	4 hours	Payment required for 4 hours
3P	6 hours	Payment required for 6 hours
4P	8 Hours	Payment required for 8 hours



Off-street parking in Darwin

West Lane and Dragonfly carparks:

- Display the disability parking permit at all times.
- Follow the time limit shown on the sign.
- If the sign says “PAID” or “PAY & DISPLAY”, pay for half of the allowed parking time.

Open-air off-street carparks

- Display the disability parking permit at all times.
- No payment is required.
- These carparks include:
 - McMinn Street
 - Woods/Daly Street
 - 96 Mitchell Street
 - Mitchell/Daly Street
 - McLachlan Street
 - Darwin Oval
 - Nichols Place.

Location	Time allowed	Payment required
Marked disabled bay: West Lane and Dragonfly Carpark	As signed (2P or All day)	First half of parking period (Eg Pay 1 hours for 2 hours or 4 hours for all day parking)
Non-disabled bay: West Lane and Dragonfly Carpark	All day	Pay for entire time vehicle is parked
Open-air off-street carpark	All day	Nil
