6. ATTACHMENT CHECKLIST

A site plan (dimensioned) detailing the following:

- a. location of the host business, including the address and entrance
- b. neighbouring properties (at least two on either side of the host)
- c. the proposed Parklet location and its distance from any nearby intersections, dimension to be taken from the kerb of the intersecting road
- d. on-street adjacent features such as footpath widths, trees, utilities, bike racks, ticket machine, streetlights, other carparks
- e. pedestrian thoroughfare

- □ Section 40 (to be provided prior to final approval of application)
- Traffic Engineer
- Parklet drawings (dimensioned), at a minimum detailing the following:
 - a. Dimensions the total area including but not limited to the footpath, distances of tables to boundaries and other fixtures, and any other information deemed relevant
 - b. Accessibility the Parklet should be wheel chair accessible et and, to and from the parklet to the footpath.
 - c. Barriers height, construction/materiality
 - d. Furniture allocation of fixed chairs. Propose location of removable tables, chairs and umbrellas
 - e. Planting/Landscaping proposed species
 - f. Drainage proposed design solution to avoid obstruction of existing stormwater drainage
 - g. Materials location and any relevant product specifications
 - h. Lighting location, amount, product specifications
 - *i.* Vehicle sightlines, if adjacent an intersection
- □ Written consent from adjoining businesses
- □ Copy of Certificates of Currency of Public Liability Insurance to a value in accordance with Council requirements that lists City of Darwin as an interested party within the policy

If relevant:

- Copy of a current Eating Establishment License
- □ Proof of access to appropriate toilet facilities
- □ Any other additional information to support the application
