## GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING FOR A CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR ON COUNCIL PROPERTY PERMIT

- A permit application will only be considered in conjunction with an event or an occasion.
- If a permit application is not supported by the Northern Territory Police then the application will not be considered.
- Please note that the Northern Territory Police require the lodgment of this permit application 10 working days prior to the event or occasion. Permit applications are required to be lodged at Darwin Police Station and are to be signed by the Superintendent of the Police Station.
- A permit will not be issued beyond midnight, with the exception of New Year Eve.

### General Conditions of Permit

- Permit only relates to the consumption of alcohol on or at the area/premises to which the permit relates during the hours specified. Members of the Northern Territory Police or an Authorised Officer may ask to inspect the permit at any time.
- The permit does not authorise the sale of alcohol.
- Alcohol is not to be provided to, or consumed, by persons under the age of eighteen (18) years.
- Alcohol is not to be supplied or allowed to be consumed by persons who are intoxicated.
- A permit is for the consumption of alcohol only and does not reserve any public facility for exclusive use by the person nominated in this permit.
- The person named in the permit is responsible for the collection and disposal of all introduced litter.

### Particular Conditions

**NB:** Permits are issued at the discretion of Council. Council may grant a permit, refuse to issue a permit, or cancel a permit which has been issued

**Collection Notice** City of Darwin collects personal information from you, including your personal contact details. We collect this information for the purpose of updating our administrative systems to be able to carry out Council's functions. The *Local Government Act 2019* allows or authorises us to collect this personal information and you may seek access to this information.
