The Strategy provides information and initiatives for four key areas:

- Responsible dog and cat ownership
- Pets in public places
- Pound operations
- Improvements in animal management operations

What will the Strategy achieve?

The key aims of the Strategy are:

- To support and facilitate the benefits of animal ownership and companionship
- Ensure standards of animal welfare are maintained
- Minimise local nuisance and maximise residential amenity
- Ensure the keeping of animals does not compromise acceptable standards of public health
