



PUBLIC COMPUTER AND INTERNET CONDITIONS OF USE

Users of City of Darwin Libraries' public access computers and the internet agree to the following conditions:

- Members will be able to book for one hour and non-members for thirty minutes of computer time. Additional time may be booked depending on availability. A maximum daily usage of two hours for library members and one hour for non-members applies.
- Bookings may be made up to 28 days in advance.
- Bookings will be forfeited ten minutes past the booking time if the user has not arrived.
- All computers will shut down five minutes before the library closing time.
- Work in progress must be saved before the end of a booking as the user will be automatically logged out and all unsaved work will be lost. USB sticks are available for purchase from the customer service desk.
- The parent/guardian accepts liability and responsibility for their child's access to the internet and the content that is viewed.
- Computer users are subject to City of Darwin's By-laws and the Libraries' Code of Conduct.
- The internet is not to be used to access or transmit material that is offensive, pornographic or objectionable.
- Internet users are responsible for the cost of all printing as detailed in City of Darwin's Fees and Charges.
- Material found on the internet is protected by Copyright Law.
- City of Darwin Libraries monitors usage of the internet through the application of automated content filtering software.

Any user identified as breaching the above conditions will be denied access to the internet.
